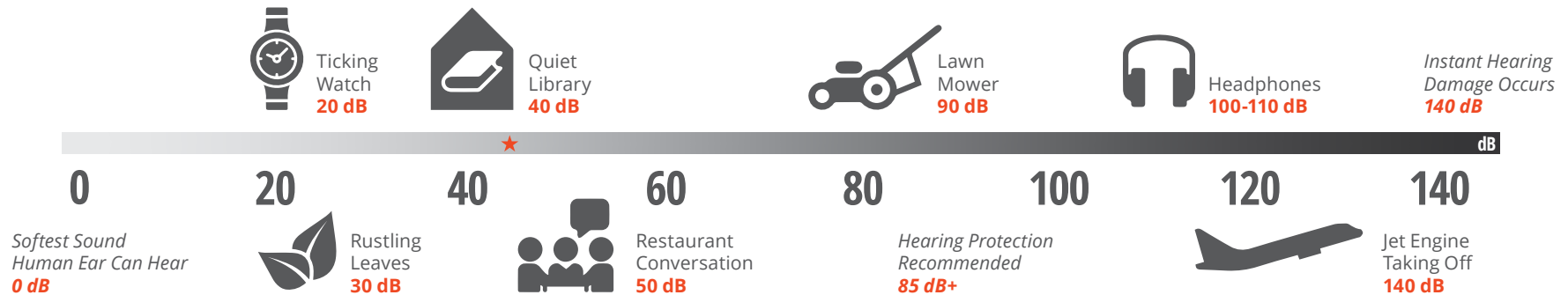

Washer Decibel Levels

Let's Talk Decibels.

Decibels are the unit of measure for the varying levels of sound. Even one decibel can equate to a noticeable difference between sounds. The Speed Queen top load washer is measured at 43 decibels, while a top competitor was recorded at 50 decibels. That 7 decibel difference equates to being almost 50% quieter than that of the competitor model running comparable cycles!



Why is it So Quiet?

The 2018 Speed Queen top load washing machine is so quiet, you may question whether or not it's working until you hear the water swooshing back and forth. The top load washer creates momentum that pushes water through the clothes, similar to an ocean wave; powerful and quiet.
